SATURDAY MORNING, DECEMBER 7 & 8



We are grateful that Sr. Sarah of the Society of St. Margaret will be leading us again in a **Quiet Day**.

On Saturday the 7th she will be leading our 16th annual Advent quiet day. This is a wonderful opportunity to spiritually prepare for Advent and the coming of Christmas. There is a sign-up sheet in the Narthex.*

The Quiet Day provides a gift of a few short hours to slow down during the hectic holiday season. It is an opportunity to be centered intentionally on God's love for us and the world and to respond to that love.

The Quiet Day combines guided meditations, provided by Sr. Sarah, with periods of silence for prayer, reading or whatever each of us if led to do during this time set apart from the usual busy-ness and distraction of our ordinary lives.

Prior to entering The Society of St. Margaret in 2000, Sister Sarah taught French and English at an Episcopal boarding school in Virginia. She was ordained to the diaconate in the Diocese of Massachusetts in 2010 and to the priesthood in 2011. After a year as priest assistant at St. Luke's-San Lucas in Chelsea, she worked for a year and a half with the Sisters in Haiti before returning to the Mother House in Massachusetts.
